Overview of Harness Training Options Available


Harness has world-class training facilities in Brisbane, Toowoomba, Chinchilla and Port Moresby (Papua New Guinea). We also offer onsite training at client facilities and a range of eLearning training options and packages.

Toowoomba Facility

Harness opened its doors in Toowoomba in May 2016 and since then the Harness Toowoomba team has expanded to include a full team of Trainers, Account Managers and support staff working to service the training needs of businesses across the Western Downs. The Harness State-of-the-Art training facility is located in Harristown, Toowoomba, with a range of safety training taking place each week.

Harness Toowoomba facility includes:

- 4 training rooms with the ability to train 50 participants per day;
- Safety & Induction simulator for safety courses
- Plant & equipment simulator for Forklift licenses and Elevated Work Platform (EWP) courses.


The Mobile Training Unit provides customers with a way to deliver training to their teams on-site at your business or another suitable location of your choice, thus achieving four key benefits:
